

APPLICATION FOR A-LEVEL ADMISSION

INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES

Please read the following information carefully before completing the application.

1. Sci-Tech offers two-years a level program. In the first year, you study the first half of the A-level called AS-level and sit for International Advanced Subsidiary (IAS Examinations). In the second year, you study the A2 level modules and also sit for examinations at the end of that year. Your combined results for both years are your A-level grade. All international examinations are done at Pharo secondary school in *Sheikh*.
2. Candidates are admitted on the basis of IGCSE results, academic and co-curricular achievements.
3. All Sci-Tech students take a minimum of three A-level subjects. In case a student needs to take a *fourth subject*, this has to be approved by the admissions committee. Kindly note that a student taking 4 A-level subjects will pay an additional monthly tuition fee of \$40.
4. Subject choices are reviewed and approved by an Academic Counsellor and finalized after IGCSE results are submitted. However, a student can be given conditional offer at the beginning of the programme which is subject to withdrawal if the conditions aren't met within the stipulated period.
5. Candidates applying for admission should have completed a minimum of 5 I.G.C.S.E. Level subjects (English and Mathematics compulsory) with a minimum grade of C {4}
6. Candidates must submit the following supporting documents with their application.
 - (a) Official school transcripts for year 10 and 11.
 - (b) Official or projected IGCSE level grades.
 - (c) Two passport size, coloured photographs.
 - (d) A Copy of passport or National ID card.
 - (e) Admission fee of \$50
7. Candidates are responsible for ensuring that their application and supporting documents are complete and submitted on time. Sci-Tech reserves the right to revoke admission or enrolment if any false, inaccurate or omitted information is found at any time during a student's enrolment at Sci-Tech.
8. Admissions Committee reviews all applications and its decision is final.
9. Official IGCSE results must be submitted to the Admissions Office within 3 days of being received by the candidate. Any significant variance from predicted grades will be reviewed by the Admission Committee.
